

The **receptive realities** of the Val del Lago are able to satisfy the seasonal tourist demand and to respond to the needs of their customers also thanks to the accessory services present on the territory: to meet the needs of the visitor, information and hospitality is provided through the mutual promotion of accommodation realities, but also in newsstands, bars, B&Bs, which become the first tourist operators, in their own way integrated with the institutional system of information offices and welcoming tourist of the territory. 




CUISINE The cuisine of the Friulian tradition is **a simple cuisine**, which proposes humble dishes but maximizing the richness and particularity of the flavors, a result of the experience and passion that every Friulian always puts in in carrying out things. The ancient recipes are linked to the **seasonal products of the fields, the stable, the courtyard and the woods**. The dishes and typical products are today sought after for their genuineness and delicacy. In local stores you can buy typical products like salami, sausages in general, fresh and seasoned cheeses, honey, jams, syrups, etc..

DISHES ... the varieties of **bread**; **polenta**, cooked long and compact, to be accompanied with roasts and stews, *frico*, with game dishes or stewed trout; salami, bacon, and other **sausages**; **cheeses**, fresh or seasoned; **omelettes** with wild herbs; the herb or bean **soup**; **risotto** with "sclopit" (maidenstears); potato or pumpkin **gnocchi** seasoned with butter, ricotta and sage or with game sauce; the **tripe**; the **brovada** with *musetto* (a kind of sausage); the pork **shank**; grilled **sausage**, wine sausage or sausage with soft *polenta* and ricotta (*toc di braida*); pork **ribs** with cabbage; vinegar **salami**; **frico**, in the crumbly version or with fresh cheese and potatoes; the grilled trout ...





AROMATIC HERBS AND FLORA The whole territory has very different natural elements, interesting for enjoying the landscape in your free time but also as a resource. Indeed, this resource has been used for centuries as a base for a subsistence economy and today it is an added value for personal well-being and a culinary ingredient for the preparation of typical dishes. Mount San Simeone and Mount Corno are in fact full of officinal herbaceous species and plants that can be used for cooking purposes, including: mallow (for mouth hygiene and care), hypericum (natural antidepressant), the dog rose, wild asparagus, "sbite" or sea buckthorn, maidenstears, wild hop. There are also many species of flowers on our territory: the wild lily, the martagon lily, the carline thistles, the iris, the edelweiss, the gentian.



EVENTS There are plenty of opportunities to celebrate and taste traditional Friulian and lake dishes, from small village festivals to events such as: the "Festa del Pesce" (lit. "Fish Festival") in Somplago held in early July, where you can enjoy fresh fish of Friuli and the Adriatic. The festival takes place on the Lake shore, near the Hydroelectric Power Plant of Somplago, for the occasion open to visitors; the "Festa del lampone e del mirtillo" (lit. "Raspberry and blueberry festival") of Avasinis (second weekend of August), with the fruits harvested on the slopes of the nearby mountains and always used in the country for snacks, drinks, jams and for health and cosmetics. Summer is also colored by events and meeting opportunities, the splendid setting of the lake will surround a suggestive **fireworks display** (14th August) and sporting events that actually enhance this magnificent part of Friuli, passing by bicycle racing to canoeing, from paragliding to windsurfing all this and much more. In the hamlet of Alesso, on the New Year's Eve, the main square and streets covered with Savoy cabbage, viscia (wild turnip tops) and historic flags are the setting for this highly original festival ("Festa dei Coscritti", lit. "Draftee festival") that has been repeated for over 150 years. A show of dances in traditional costume and parades of decorated floats, where young people greet the new year in a particular historical fusion of ancient rites of initiation into adulthood with the duties derived from the institution of military service.





The territory of the Val del Lago is an idea environmental context for the practice of physical and sport activity: there are greer areas in contexts of peace and tranquility which only a natural environment can guarantee. There is also the possibility of attending playgrounds, present in almost all the towns in the valley, as well as practicing tennis, soccer, basketball. Sports courts are also available in every municipal area (information on site).

What to do on the lake ...

- A walk to the Bordano lakes:
- an excursion on Mount San Simeone, with a stop on a vantage point that allows you to see the town of Bordano from above and with a visit to the small church on the Mount:
- a walk dedicated to the harvesting of wild herbs and mushrooms found on Mount San Simeone:
- a mountain bike excursion from the Pass of Interneppo to the Fort of Mount Festa, stopping at the fountains and in the most interesting vantage points;
- a walk through the center of Bordano and Interneppo to see the murals representing the butterflies and a visit to the Butterfly House;
- a visit to the **Museum of the Fortress**, in Cavazzo Carnico;
- a visit to the **Vuarbis marsh**, in Cavazzo Carnico;

- a circumnavigation of the Cavazzo lake or "Lago dei Tre Comuni", appreciating the Roman remains, including the traces of the ancient Salt Road (*Cjasaria Muarta*), the Roman bridge of Somplago and also making an excursion to the Parish church of Santo Stefano in Cesclans. Don't forget a visit to the Visitor Center of the Interneppo Botanical Park (operating site of the Ecomuseum);
- bathing in the **Palâr** and **Leale** streams:
- recreational fishing;
- an excursion and possible overnight stay at the Malga on Mount Corno (mountain hut), known for its endemic flora:
- excursions on the hills surrounding the Val del Lago, full of hiking trails that allow you to reach breathtaking landscapes.

... and in the surroundings

The surroundings offer opportunities for visits to the medieval centers of Venzone and Gemona, the Napoleonic fortress of Osoppo, the natural reserve of the Cornino lake where the griffon vultures nest, apart from the occasions to celebrate with the other village festivals of the surroundings such as the pumpkin festival in Venzone, the medieval August of Gemona, the "Festa del formaggio" in Gemona, the "Purcit in staiare" festival in Artegna, the "Mestieri, arti e sapori in the Val d'Arzino" in Forgaria, the "Festa delle castagne" in Montenars, the carnival of Resia and many other meeting opportunities.
